

# **Our Topic**

Our new topic is 'Enchanted Woodland'. In science, we are going to be learning about plants. In geography, we will developing our mapping skills including how to use compass points. # **PSHE**

#### Focus this term:

Unit I: Relationships— Children's breadth of relationships is widened to include people they may find in their school community. They consider their own significant relationships and why these are special and important. They begin to consider healthy and safe relationships.

Unit 2: Changing me-Children are introduced to life cycles and look at simple changes from baby to adult, . They discuss how they have changed so far and that people grow up at different rates. Change is discussed as a natural and normal part of getting older which can bring about happy and sad feelings.

#### Home Learning YEAR |

A book banded reading book will be sent home daily and changed on a Friday.
