Two year groups had school trips today and the weather was perfect! As part of their current topic 'Animal Habitats', Year 2 visited Paradise Wildlife Park (now known as Hertfordshire Zoo). There, the children received a perfect blend of education and fun. They learned lots of interest facts about some amazing mammals, primates, reptiles and birds. The life sized animatronic dinosaurs in the zoo's 'World of Dinosaurs' attraction was brilliant.







Year 4 went to Mountfitchet Castle, which was formally an Iron Age fort and a Roman, Saxon and Viking settlement. As part of their topic '1066'. The children explored the motte and bailey castle and had plenty of fun experiencing life in a Norman village around 1066. To broaden the children's experiences, they travelled by train there and back. Well done to all the children as they waited so patiently after experiencing delays to their train. We are very proud of them as they were a real credit to the school.
