Enriching the curriculum

On Monday morning, as part of our 'History of Transport week' the children were treated to a wonderful display of classic and modern cars. This included cars from each decade from 1950s, including a Morgan Plus 4 and Riley Kestrel to a brand new Hyundai Ioniq 6. Children were given the opportunity to develop their historical skills, including using sources to ask questions and understanding change and development. All the children came to view the cars, which were parked up on the playground and asked the owners questions. The children were thrilled to see the array of cars that spanned nearly 75 years of history. Thank you to everyone who brought their cars into school and to Mr Sainsbury and Miss Cotterell for organising the event.



Divergent Drama, a travelling theatre group, delivered workshops this week to Y1,2,3,5 and 6. Each class were encouraged to use divergent thinking. The children travelled through time to many different countries and met the inventors and pioneers of different forms of transport throughout the ages. Thanks to the PTA for funding theses workshops.

On Monday, Miss Wise, an ex-student, who is now a flight attendant with Ryanair, explained to the children of Y1 and Y2 insights into working for an airline. The children pretended they were on a flight and really enjoyed learning all about air travel in this immersive way.

Year 4 had an Egyptologist to run their workshop on transport in Egyptian times. They focused on water transport and learned how nature had already built a superhighway right through the middle of their empire called the River Nile.
