### Safeguarding:

#### Parking Reminder – Please Park Safely and Legally

We kindly remind all parents and carers to park responsibly around the school. Roads such as Willow Close and nearby streets are permit-only, and vehicles must not be parked there without a valid permit, regardless of the length of stay. Parking wardens are authorised to issue fines to any vehicle not displaying the correct permit.

We have received a **serious report** of a car being left unattended with the engine running and a small child inside. This is both unsafe and illegal under UK law. Leaving a vehicle with the engine running while unattended poses significant risks, including potential accidents or theft.

As a reminder, free parking is available at the Rugby Club, just a 3-minute walk from the school. We strongly encourage all families to make use of this facility whenever possible.

Thank you for helping us keep our school community safe and respectful of our neighbours.
