This buys you one or more membership number(s) (which we will allocate), to be entered into the monthly draw. All participants must be over 16. The draw will take place at the end of each month. If you win, a cheque will be posted to your home address and the name of the winner published in the school's monthly newsletter.

The contributions will be split 40% towards the prize fund and 60% towards the school fund to help fund equipment, resources and opportunities for the children of Northgate.

250 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 250 Club is to raise funds for Northgate Primary School. The money will be paid into the PTA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, maintenance and opportunities for the children and Northgate.

RULES

- 1. For a cost of a minimum of £10 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 250.
- 2. A draw will take place every month.
- 3. The monthly prize will total 40% of that month's income.
- 4. The 250 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Northgate Primary School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- 5. Numbers are unlimited to purchase.
- 6. Payments must be made by standing order monthly. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
- 7. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 8. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number will be excluded from the draw and, if payments are not resumed the following month, may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
- 9. The draw shall be made by a member of the PTA each month.
- 10. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application.
- 11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be printed in the school newsletter, posted on the PTA Facebook closed group and on the school website.
- 12. The 250 Club will be run by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
- 13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 250 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA funds after six months.
